NEXT STOP - IRB DRIVERS COURSE

Calling all IRB Crew members! If you are interested in training for your IRB Drivers Award, please visit the Lifeguarding Facebook page and comment on the Drivers Course post.

Pre-requisites:

- Have your Lifeguard award and be refreshed
- Have your IRB Crew award or be currently working towards it
- 16 years old to drive an IRB

The training takes place on a Sunday morning at the club and includes theory and practical learning. The start date is yet to be confirmed so please keep an eye on the Facebook page for updates.

GOODBYE SiteDocs, HELLO PATROL APP!

From July 1st all Operational Risk Assessments (ORAs) should be completed on the Surf Patrol App. Over the last few years we have been using a range of methods to record risk assessments. We started with the humble paper form to the introduction of Connecteams and then onto SiteDocs, all the time dreaming of having our own SLSNZ Application that can do it all. And now we have it! The move to recording ORAs in the Patrol App has streamlined our risk management requirements by only having to use one platform.

Online training on this new method has already started but for those who use SiteDocs regularly we recommend you attend one of the in-person training sessions:


We are required to send one official for every 10 athletes to carnivals and events. We will have to consider restricting entries to events if we don't have
