#### OFFICIALS NEEDED FOR NEXT SEASON

As our sports teams continue to grow, we need to provide officials for the upcoming carnivals. This is a fantastic opportunity to get an up-close view of the competition and support our athletes, as well as support the club. The next Level One Officials Course will be held at the Mount Maunganui Lifeguard Service on August 20. More information can be found here.

With several of our current officials moving up with their athletes to the senior ranks, we're particularly in need of new officials for our Oceans age group.

David Cox, a junior surf committee member, age group surf coach, lifeguard, and surf competition official, shares:



"We need you! As a surf lifesaving club, we send our children to surf carnivals, but we also need to send a percentage of qualified surf officials to ensure these events run smoothly. Right now, we're low on officials for junior surf sports and are actively recruiting. Without enough officials, we may have to limit our participation in surf carnivals. Consider joining us - it's a rewarding way to engage with the surf carnival beyond just spectating."

#### Here's what you need to know:

**No Lifeguard Qualification Needed:** You don't need to be a qualified lifeguard to be an official. **Open To All:** You don't need to have a child racing or participating in junior surf, any member can be an official.

Flexible Availability: You don't have to attend every carnival or age group. You can focus on the events that suit you and your family.

Training Provided: You'll receive training from qualified trainers and no previous experience is needed.


#### Perks of being an official:

Free Meals: You're provided with food all day.

Close to the Action: You'll be right in the action, witnessing your kids' reactions, determination, and emotions.

**Great Community:** You'll be part of a group of like-minded individuals, cheering on and organizing the kids. **Easy Day:** Your role mainly involves directing kids, recording results, explaining race procedures, and enjoying coffee - it's a straightforward and enjoyable day at the beach.
